
Netgear Orbi RBK852 Setup, Login & Support Guide

- Turn both units on. (The Router is the one with the label RBR85 & the Satellite is the one with the RBS850 label).
- ▶ Take the power and ethernet out of your modem to turn it off altogether.
- Plug the ethernet wire that comes with it into the LAN/Internet port on your modem.
- Plug in the other end of the yellow WAN connection on the back of the Orbi Router.
- Make sure that your modem is turned on and wait for the lights to stop blinking before proceeding.
- Once that is complete, connect the power adapter for the Orbi Router to a wall socket as well as the rear of the router unit.

Note: The ring LED on top of the router will blink white. This signals that the device is starting up. The ring will light up in pure white color when it's ready to be set up.)

Satellite Setup

- Find a place 2–3 rooms away from the router, preferably with an open passage (avoid too many walls or floors in the way).
- Connect the Satellite's power adapter to the RBS850 device and plug it in.
- ▶ The LED on the top ring will pulse white to show that it's turning on.
- It will attempt to connect to the router on its own after two minutes.



Look at the color of the LED:

- Blue implies a solid relationship
- Amber signifies a reasonable connection (now you can move it a little closer)
- Magenta indicates no connection (resync or move).

If the indicator remains magenta for more than two minutes, press the router and satellite Sync buttons within two minutes.

Let Them Sync

- The satellite LED ring should turn off entirely after the communication is established.
- Orbi RBK852 Setup is donephysically. The next step is to conclude the Orbi RBK852 setup using either an app or a web browser.


Configuring the Device

1. Setting up via Netgear Orbi app

- Get the Orbi app from the Apple App Store or Google Play.
- Make a Netgear account or log in to the existing one. After clicking "Set up an Orbi", scan the router's QR code.
- Now fill in the credentials asked (username & password). The details are provided on the device's label.
- Once you're able to perform Orbi login successfully, this dashboard allows you to change your WiFi name, password, and admin credentials. Now, follow the on-screen instructions.
- Connect the satellite and let it sync automatically. The LED will pulse white and change color. Then, follow the instructions in the app to finish pairing.

1. Setting Up Your Web Browser Manually

- Use an Ethernet or WiFi to connect your device to the router.
- Now open any browser, go to orbilogin.net or 192.168.1.1
- > Fill in the details and log in using your admin and password (The details are provided on router's label)
- The Setup Wizard often detects your ISP connection directly. Set the SSID, password, admin login, select among IPv4/IPv6, and PPPoE if needed.
- After setting up the router, connect the satellite. It syncs automatically. You can check its condition and upgrade its firmware using the web interface, whenever required.
