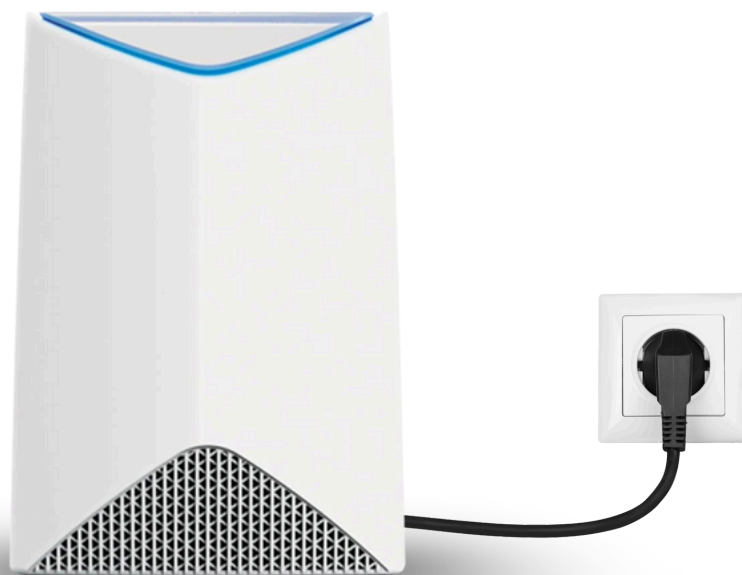
Cabling Orbi Router with Modem

- Plug the SRK60 router into your modem using the yellow Internet port with the help of the Ethernet cable. Power it on. Wait. And then wait some more because the boot-up feels like it takes forever. When that power LED finally turns solid white, you're good.



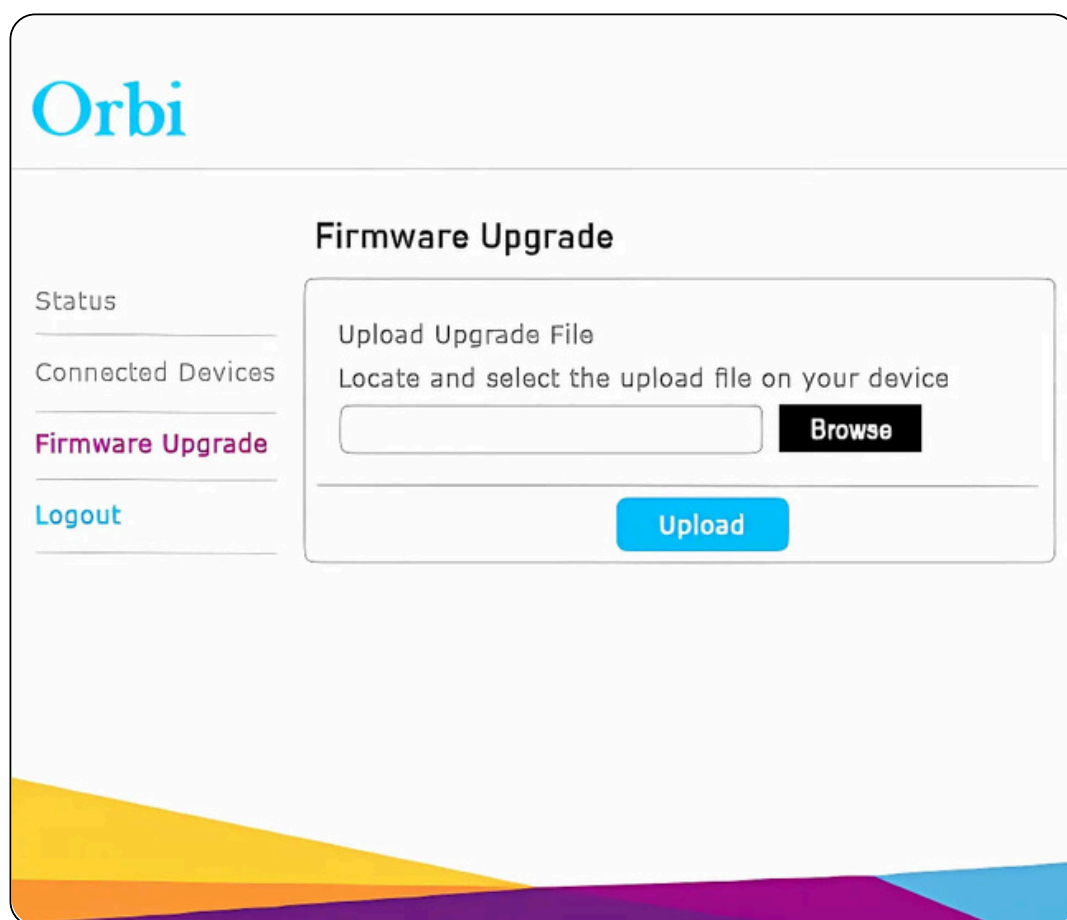
Orbi Router App Setup

- Download the Orbi App iOS or Android. Just search “Orbi” in the app store. Make sure it’s the official Netgear one (purple icon, white O).
- Start with your Netgear account, or create one if you never bothered before.
- Plug in the main SRK60 router. Not the satellites yet. Wait for the power LED to turn solid white, then amber, then finally blue or white again.



- The app will ask: Add an Orbi system? Yes. Let it scan. Sometimes it takes forever — if it fails, close the app, reopen. It’ll usually pick it up the second try.
- You’ll name your WiFi network and set a password. Pro tip: the Pro system lets you do VLAN stuff later, but for now just keep it simple. Single SSID, WPA2.

- Once the main router is online, plug in the satellites. Place them where you actually need coverage.
- The LED should go blue after syncing (good), amber (meh but fine), or magenta (nope). If it's magenta for more than a minute or two, hit Sync on both devices.
- The app will likely scream at you to update firmware. Do it now. It takes like 5–10 minutes, and the whole system reboots.
- Once you see the dashboard in the app, you're good. Check the device list, test your speeds. If the app keeps spinning on "Configuring," but the internet works.
