HOW TO SET UP?

Orbi RBS760 setup can be done via two methods. One is via browser and other is via sync button:



Setup via App or Browser

- Put the satellite in a room that isn't too far away from the main Orbi router. The appropriate place to set it up would be halfway between weak points and the router.
- Plug in the power adapter and wait for the LED to start blinking.
- Connect the satellite to your network using the Orbi app (iOS and Android) or web interface orbilogin.net.



- If everything is in place, the system will sync automatically. When plugged in, a solid LED appears.
- Check the connection strength across the home after synchronization.

That's the simple method. It doesn't always work well the first time, however. The LED may stay amber for a while, or the app may not discover it right away. That's when you have to figure out what's wrong.

Setup via Sync Button

You can feel that the app is too much, or you might simply want the quickest method. The procedure using the sync button works fine:

- Turn on the Orbi router and wait for it to finish starting up.
- Connect the Orbi RBS760 satellite and wait for the LED to become solid white and then start pulsating.
- On the back of your Orbi router, press the Sync button.
- Press the Sync button on the satellite within two minutes.

- The LED will change colors when pairing. Blue implies a strong connection, amber means a reasonable connection, and magenta means a failed connection.
- You're fine to go if it's blue or amber. If it remains magenta, get the satellite closer and try again.

This way is fast and doesn't need a phone or a login page. For secondary satellites, a lot of people like it better.
